Find Public Notices every week in this newspaper.

Public notices (also referred to as legal notices or legal ads) in general circulation newspapers are fundamental to a free society, a permanent and verifiable record that the public was adequately informed about decisions taken or about to be taken.

Each week *The Ellsworth American* and *Mount Desert Islander* publish dozens of public notices about events, conditions or actions that affect individuals, neighborhoods and businesses of Hancock County and surrounding areas.

Public Notice pages appear every week in our newspaper. All public notices – in-column and display – are placed on these pages. A banner with artwork, a definition of public notices and why they are important heads the page(s). An individual template may be designed for municipalities so that readers immediately recognize whether the ad involves their community. Public notice pages are listed in the front page index of both newspapers and house ads throughout the paper help educate readers to the importance of public notices and where to find them in their newspaper.

Public Notice advertisers may purchase frequency contracts and enjoy the same discounts available to retail advertisers. A notarized affidavit with tear sheets to verify publication is mailed to public notice advertisers upon request following the last insertion date. Billing statements are mailed the first of the month.
